He is an orthodontic specialist practicing in Winnipeg, Canada.

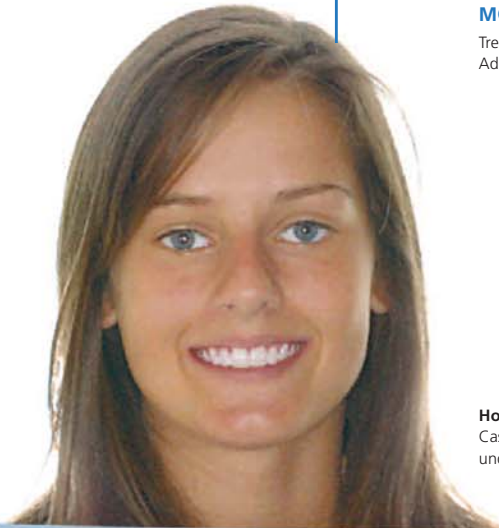
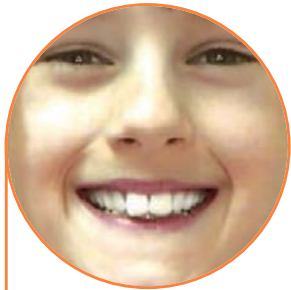
He is also a past assistant professor of graduate orthodontics at the University of Manitoba.
